Eligibility Requirements

- A valid or pending Michigan Teaching Certificate
- * General education teachers without a special education endorsement must complete a set of approved foundation courses in addition to the required courses.

Tuition Reimbursement

Partial tuition reimbursement is available to students who are certified teachers in Michigan and eligible for the program.

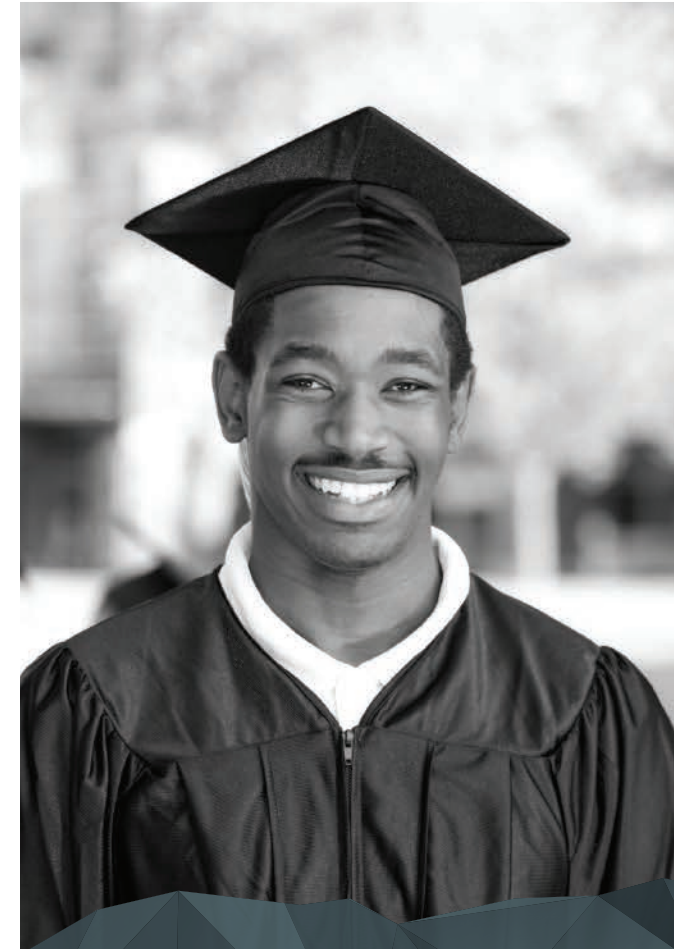
